School's Strategy

This diversity enriches the learning environment but also necessitates tailored support services to ensure all students can thrive. The school aims to improve its support systems, including language assistance, innovative teaching methodologies for students with language barriers and to better cater to the needs of our diverse learners.

To address these challenges, the school plans to enhance its staff mobility programs.
